Conservation notes: All items placed into acid-free folders and envelopes within an archival box. Metal fasteners have been removed.

Scope and Content: The collection contains papers, publications, ephemera and memorabilia of KDHX. Included is an incomplete run of *Airwaves* from 1983 to 2008. *Airwaves* is the the official publication of KDHX issued to members that contributed \$40 or more annually to the station.

KDHX is a community radio that KDHX began construction in March of 1982, but did not go on the air until 1987. It broadcasts at 88.1 mHz. The station is licensed to the Double Helix Corporation. In 2013, KDHX moved to the Larry J. Weir Center for Independent Media (3524 Washington Avenue) after more than twenty-five years at 3504 Magnolia Avenue.
