Scope and Content: The collection contains administrative files, publications, and

ephemera of KSTL Radio.

KSTL-AM broadcasted in 1948 and has been a Christian station since its beginning. At first, the station only aired Christian music, but soon hosted Christian talk radio programs as well. It wasn't until 1954 that the new General Manager Dick Kasten began to change the format of the station. During his management, DJ Spider Burks signed on to host jazz programs. Burks was one of St.

Louis radio's first black DJs.

It was also during Kasten's term that KSTL-FM first sign on the air on April 2, 1960. The station lasted seven years and was then sold to Foreground Music, Inc., who changed the call letters to

KRCH, in 1967.
